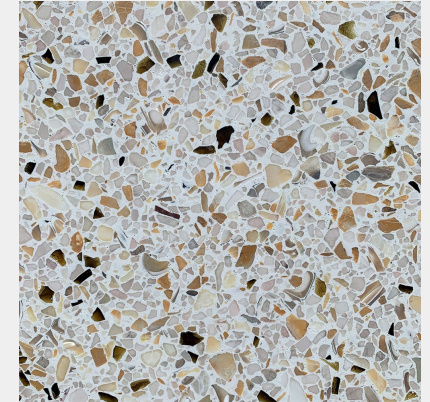


Durabella Terrazzo

Durabella Terrazzo flooring is composed of marble aggregates and/or natural stones with a vegetable oil-based binder. This healthier alternative to epoxy flooring is Red List Free and passes VOC emissions standards for the level of Indoor Air Comfort. The production of this product currently requires the use of isocyanates. While the manufacturer avoids the more harmful toluene diisocyanate (TDI), any isocyanate can be hazardous when the product is wet. Therefore, installers should use proper protection. Durabella is customizable and can be applied to interior and exterior surfaces.
